

Esport Canada Community Guidelines Agreement

Esport Canada strives provide a safe and welcoming environment for players to compete and an inclusive space for spectators, coaches, and organizers to connect and enjoy the game. Participation in any Esport Canada tournaments or events requires adherence to the following set of community guidelines for sportsmanship, conduct and ethics.

All Players, Coaches, Spectators, and Organizers must:

- Strive to enhance the safety of all esports participants, spectators, coaches, and organizers by treating everyone with respect, never condoning the use of offensive language, nicknames, or any form of insult towards yourself or others. This includes, but is not limited to racism, sexism, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, age, or physical ability.
- Uphold the values of sportsmanship, digital citizenship, and integrity by creating a space that is
 free of language or gestures (physically or in-game) inferring sexual violence or inciting other
 forms of violence, spamming, or cheating and use of appropriate screen names.
- Respect all participant and spectator information as private and confidential. All age restrictions,
 Terms of Service, and Privacy Policies for each game, client, and program must be strictly adhered to.
